



Privacy Policy

At Cribba, we are committed to protect and respect your privacy. This policy sets out the basis on which we collect personal data, and how personal data you provide to us is processed:

Personal data we may collect from you:

To improve the use and access of our website, for marketing and analysis, we may collect information from your use of our website including your IP address, browser, traffic data, location data, content from surveys and forms and any other communication data you access.

We may store cookies.

How we use your personal information in the following as it is permitted by applicable data protection law:

To respond to your request from the contact form,

To provide you with the services you request from us,

To perform analytical research on our candidate base and clients for content and services you are interested in.

Where it is necessary to comply with any legal, government, regulator or police investigations or obligations.

To respond or investigate any complaints.

You do not have to provide your personal data to us but to provide the tailored service you require this is necessary.

To transfer data to third parties.

We will retain your information unless you notify us, you no longer wish us to do so.



Sharing and storing your data

Your data may be processed and transferred within the European Union, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

We take all reasonable steps to ensure your data is treated and stored securely.

From time to time, we may use a third-party supplier, however, your data remains under our control. They will only have access to your personal information as required for them to perform their services to us.

The transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure, we will endeavour to protect your personal information, however, any transmission is at your own risk.

Your Rights

You have the right to have your personal information corrected, if you can demonstrate this information is incorrect.

The right to access and obtain a copy of your personal information.

The right to request your personal data be removed.

You will only receive marketing communication where you have consented to do so.
